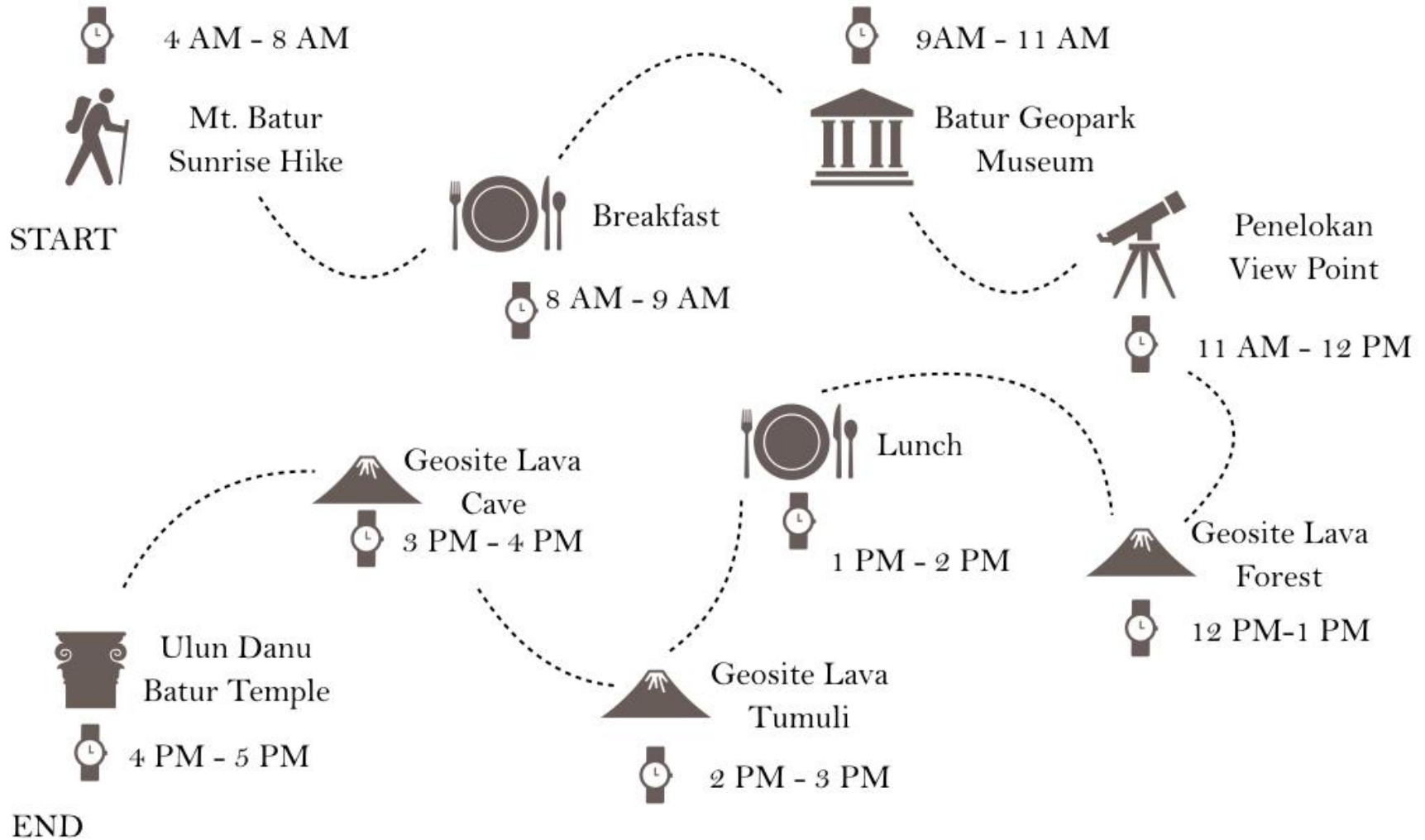

## ICES 2019 FIELD TRIP – FULL ITINERARY

Day/Date: **Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup> November 2019**

Time: **Whole Day**

TIME	LOCATION	ACTIVITY	DETAILS
04:00 – 8:00	<b>Pura Pasar Agung Batur</b>	<b>Mt. Batur Sunrise Hike</b>	The summit can be reached within an hour to two hours of hiking. The peak sits at 1,717 meters (5,633 ft.) above sea level. Offers breathtaking views of Lake Batur, black lava from the last explosion, and surrounding mountains. Enjoy this hike by getting up bright and early for the sunrise around 6:15AM-6:20AM.
08:00 – 09:00	<b>Mt. Batur</b>	<b>Breakfast</b>	All participants will have their breakfast at Lake View Batur, enjoying the stunning sights of Mt. Batur and Lake Batur.
09:00– 11:00	<b>Batur Geopark Museum</b>	<b>Visit the Museum</b>	We will find very interesting geology related information/history of the formation process and existence of volcanic activity on Bali Island.
11:00 – 12:00	<b>Penelokan View Point</b>	<b>Sightseeing</b>	A panorama of Batur Volcano, Caldera I & II and the lake.
12:00 – 13:00	<b>Geosite Lava Forest</b>	<b>Visit the Attractions</b>	The wilderness of Mt Batur lava can be observed. This was formed due to eruption of Mt Batur in 1888. Several features of lava can be observed such as lava tumuli, crust, aa and pillars.
13:00 – 14:00		<b>Lunch Break</b>	
14:00 – 15:00	<b>Geosite Lava Tumuli</b>	<b>Visit the Attractions</b>	More lava tumuli can be observed around this area. That has unique and distinctive morphology and formations which are formed by the process of pushing and accumulating pillow lava.
15:00 – 16:00	<b>Geosite Lava Cave</b>	<b>Visit the Attractions</b>	This lava cave stretches from NE-SW which estimated about 25 meters long. There are more than 3 lava caves formed at this area.
16:00 – 17:00	<b>Ulun Danu Batur Temple</b>	<b>Visit the Attractions</b>	Enjoying the beauty of Lake Batur and its iconic temple.
